Grab your passport and join us for an amazing six-week archaeological experience in Baden-Württemberg, Germany!

This six (6) credit course involves the excavation of a B-17 aircraft crash site towards the recovery of missing U.S. service members through a programmatic agreement with the Defense POW/MIA Accounting Agency and Henry M. Jackson Foundation. Students must participate for all six weeks. ****does not meet IUP's requirement for a six week North American Archaeological Field School****

Participants receive training in forensic archaeology and geophysical survey methods. We work five days a week with opportunities to explore historic and cultural sites on our days off. Hotel accommodations and meal stipend provided for participants. Roundtrip airfare to and from Germany is not included.
