## SANTA CATARINA ROMAN VILLA






- Location: Alcacer do Sal, Portugal

The Roman Villa of Santa Catarina de Sítimos is located in the southwest of Portugal, in the beautiful coast of the Alentejo region. The nearest city is Alcácer do Sal (Roman Salacia) on a small and picturesque village of the municipality of Alcácer do Sal.

This Roman villa is called by the name of the village, Santa Catarina de Sítimos and it was one of the rural settlements of the age of the famous Roman city of Alcácer do Sal, Salacia Imperatoria Urbs, the capital of the civitas, mentioned by Latin writers such as Pliny and

Strabo for the premium textiles, good quality of soils, and mine control. Its importance in previous times, especially in the Iron Age, the ancient Beuipo, with the only Phoenician colony ever excavated in Portugal in Abul, settled the base for the rising of Alcácer do Sal. It has one of the most important antique maritime harbour cities in the Atlantic ocean.
